Waste Licence Review Application W0167-03: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 to 2011

Dear Mr Jones

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.

I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 to 2011. The Site Notice as erected or fixed on the facility contravenes Article 7(1)(a) of the Regulations, insofar as the laminated notice became damaged by weather conditions and was illegible within the period during which it is required to be displayed.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations, to renew and replace the Site Notice in accordance with the requirements of Article 7(4). The Site Notice shall be maintained in position where erected or fixed for a period of one month from the date of this notice.

You are requested to submit evidence of same to the Agency. The evidence requested should be submitted within <u>one week</u> of the date of this notice, in the form of one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all drawings/maps should not exceed A3 in size.
