5. **Objection to Proposed Decision of an Application for a Waste Licence**

Licensee: **Murray Waste Recycling Limited,
Coolatore,
Ferns,
County Wexford**

Register of Licence No: **W0258-01**

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 23 February 2012; one First-Party objection received on 20 March 2012 and the report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Michael Owens gave a verbal presentation.

Technical Committee Report

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee subject to the following amendments;

Objection (iv): Condition 3.12 – Dust/Odour Control

Amend Condition 3.12(ii) to remove reference to bio-filter.

Insert new Condition 3.13 to require an assessment of a need for bio-filter or other air abatement facilities and to enable a requirement for a bio-filter to be provided, if required by OEE. Renumber all successive conditions accordingly.

Objection (v): Composite Sampling

Delete Note 1 from Schedule B.6: Storm Water Emission

Insert new *Note 1: Grab Sample* under the table for Schedule C.2.3: Monitoring of Storm Water Emissions.

Amend the heading 'Monitoring Frequency' to 'Monitoring Frequency *Note 1*'.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Murray Waste Recycling Limited for their facilities at Coolatore, Ferns, County Wexford, Register of Licence No W0258-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
