## Dear Inspector

I have already made a submission and this was acknowledged by Ann Kehoe in her letter to me on the 16<sup>th</sup> July. In her letter she suggested that a further submission could be made.

If it is possible I would like to take up this offer to make a short further submission. I will be brief.

I made the point previously of the need to measure health impacts among the local population as a result of further increases in various pollutants such as Dioxins and the various toxic chemicals contained in the PM2.5 and PM1 micro particles from the incinerator stack.

I attended a talk recently on the 27<sup>th</sup> June, hosted by the EPA at Kevin Street Dublin on the subject of studies conducted on the mortality rates in 6 US cities directly arising from PM 2.5 particulate pollutants. There is now growing and incontrovertible evidence that micro particle pollution is indeed the cause of premature death. Evidence was shown of the increase rates of premature deaths as a result of increasing levels of air pollution. The speaker on the day spoke of the closure of a coal burning fire station in the US as a result of evidence that was presented proving a link between PM 2.5's and mortality rates in down wind cities.

I want to make the point to you that any further increase of PM2.5 pollution around the Duleek and Drogheda areas will most certainly lead to an increase in premature deaths. It is therefore very important that the EPA carefully applies the precautionary principle when considering the consequences of an application to burn 20,000 tonnes per annum of hazardous waste.
