**RE: Cert of Authorisation for Historic Landfill at St. Mary's Park, Limerick as per SI No. 524 of 2008 Waste Management (Certification of Historic Unlicensed Waste Disposal and Recovery Activity) Regulations 2008.**

Dear Sir,

In accordance with Regulation 7(2) of the Waste Management (Certification of Historic Unlicensed Waste Disposal and Recovery Activity) Regulations 2008 – (the Regulations) - please find enclosed the documentation required in support of our application for a Certificate of Authorisation to remediate the historic landfill at St. Mary's Park, Limerick.

The documentation consists of a Tier 1 Assessment, Tier 2 Assessment and a Natura Impact Statement in hard copy. We also include a Tier 3 Assessment with a Detailed Quantitative Risk Analysis in disc format. Also enclosed is the completed Certificate of Authorisation Application Form together with a cheque for €5,000 in accordance with Regulation 7(3) of the Regulations. The landfill activity at St. Mary's Park is largely limited to deposition of municipal waste and the likely remediation process will be in accordance with the EPA COP for sites proximate to residential development and SAC.

As the nature of both the landfill activity and the likely remediation process are both limited, we would appreciate if you would refund the application fee as allowed by Regulation 7(3).
