TECHNICAL AMENDMENT A  
TO

## ***Reasons for the Decision***

The Environmental Protection Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that subject to compliance with the conditions of licence Reg. No. W0080-01 granted on the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2003, as well as any amendments noted herein, any emissions from the activity will comply with and not contravene any of the requirements of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011.

## ***Technical Amendment***

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 42B(1)(c) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011, the Agency amends Licence Reg. No. W0080-01, granted to Carneige JW & Co Ltd, Dillonsdown, Blessington, Co. Wicklow.

Henceforth, the licence shall be read in conjunction with the amendments set out below.

This technical amendment is limited to the following Glossary and Conditions of Licence Reg. No. W0080-01.

# *Amendments*

## **Amend Glossary of Terms as follows**

- Extractive waste** As defined in regulation 3(2) of the Waste Management (Management of Waste from the Extractive Industries) Regulations, 2009, S.I. No. 566 of 2009.
- Waste facility** As defined in regulation 3(2) of the Waste Management (Management of Waste from the Extractive Industries) Regulations 2009.

## **New Conditions**

### ***Add condition 5.11 to include the following after condition 5.10***

#### 5.11 Extractive Waste Management

The operator shall draw up a Waste Management Plan (to be known as an Extractive Waste Management Plan) for the minimisation, treatment, recovery and disposal of extractive waste. This Plan shall meet the requirements of regulation 5 of the Waste Management (Management of Waste from the Extractive Industries) Regulations, 2009. The Plan shall be submitted for agreement by the Agency by the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012. The Plan shall be reviewed at least once every five years thereafter in a manner agreeable to the Agency and amended in the event of substantial changes to the operation of a waste facility or to the waste deposited. Any amendments shall be notified to the Agency.

All extractive waste shall be managed in accordance with the Extractive Waste Management Plan. A report on the implementation of the Extractive Waste Management Plan shall be provided in the AER.

### ***Add condition 5.12 to include the following after condition 5.11.***

#### 5.12 Waste Facility

- (i) No new waste facility may be developed or an existing waste facility modified unless agreed by the Agency.
- (ii) The licensee shall ensure that all existing waste facilities are managed and maintained to ensure their physical stability and to prevent pollution or contamination of soil, air, surface water or groundwater.
- (iii) The licensee shall ensure that all new waste facilities are constructed, managed and maintained to ensure their physical stability and to prevent pollution or contamination of soil, air, surface water or groundwater.

- (iv) Operational measures shall be continuously employed to prevent damage to waste facilities from personnel, plant or equipment.
- (v) The licensee shall establish and maintain a system for regular monitoring and inspection of the waste facilities.
- (vi) All records of monitoring and inspection of waste facilities, as required under the licence, shall be maintained on-site in order to ensure the appropriate handover of information in the event of a change of operator or relevant personnel.

***Add condition 5.13 to include the following after condition 5.12***

- 5.13           Excavation Voids
- 5.13.1        Unless otherwise agreed by the Agency, only extractive waste shall be placed in excavation voids.
- 5.13.2        When placing extractive waste into excavation voids for rehabilitation and construction purposes, the licensee shall, in accordance with regulation 10 of the Waste Management (Management of Waste from the Extractive Industries) Regulations, 2009, and the Extractive Waste Management Plan:
- (i)       Secure the stability of the waste.
  - (ii)      Put in place measures to prevent pollution of soil, surface water and ground water.
  - (iii)     Carry out monitoring of the extractive waste and excavation void.

This technical amendment shall be cited as Amendment A (in pursuance of Section 42B(1) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011) to Waste Licence Register No. W0080-01.
