<b>RE:</b>	Withdrawal of waste licence review application register number W0061-03, Mr Binman Limited, Luddenmore, Grange, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick.

Mr Binman applied on 11 July 2008 for a review of a waste licence to authorise an increase in waste intake from the current maximum of 105,000 tonnes per annum to a proposed maximum of 200,000 tonnes. The application relates to an existing facility at Luddenmore, Grange, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick. Since making that application, Mr Binman went into receivership. The receiver, in correspondence with the Agency dated 21 September 2012, stated his intention to withdraw the application in accordance with article 21 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004.

I recommend that the Agency agree to the withdrawal of the licence review application W0061-03.
