Shareholders of Merging sub-fund will receive into Receiving sub-fund, up to three decimals, a total number of shares of the same class as the share held, calculated by multiplying the number of shares held in the Merging sub-fund by the exchange ratio cited below.

The exchange ratio will be calculated as at 30 November 2012 by dividing the net asset value (NAV) per share of the Merging sub-fund/classes calculated on 30 November 2012 by the corresponding NAV per share of the Receiving sub-fund/classes calculated on 30 November 2012 based on the valuation of the underlying set on 29 November 2012.
