I refer to your letter to the Agency dated 05<sup>th</sup> October 2012 which was received on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2012.


For reference, your letter mentioned a Licence Register Number W0272-01 which *is not* the Register Number for the Brownstown Quarry site. The correct Register Number is W0280-01.

Due to a limitation of resources in the Agency and an on-going embargo on recruitment in the Public Service, little or no progress has been made in the processing of the Waste Licence Application for Register Number W0280-01, Brownstown Quarry, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford.

Work is currently underway on the prioritisation of work for 2013. It is unlikely that the assessment of your application (Reg No: W0280-01) will be completed until the middle of next year. In general soil & stone operations are not being highly prioritised.

I regret the slow pace with which your application is being processed, but as I explained, this is due to a limitation on available resources.
