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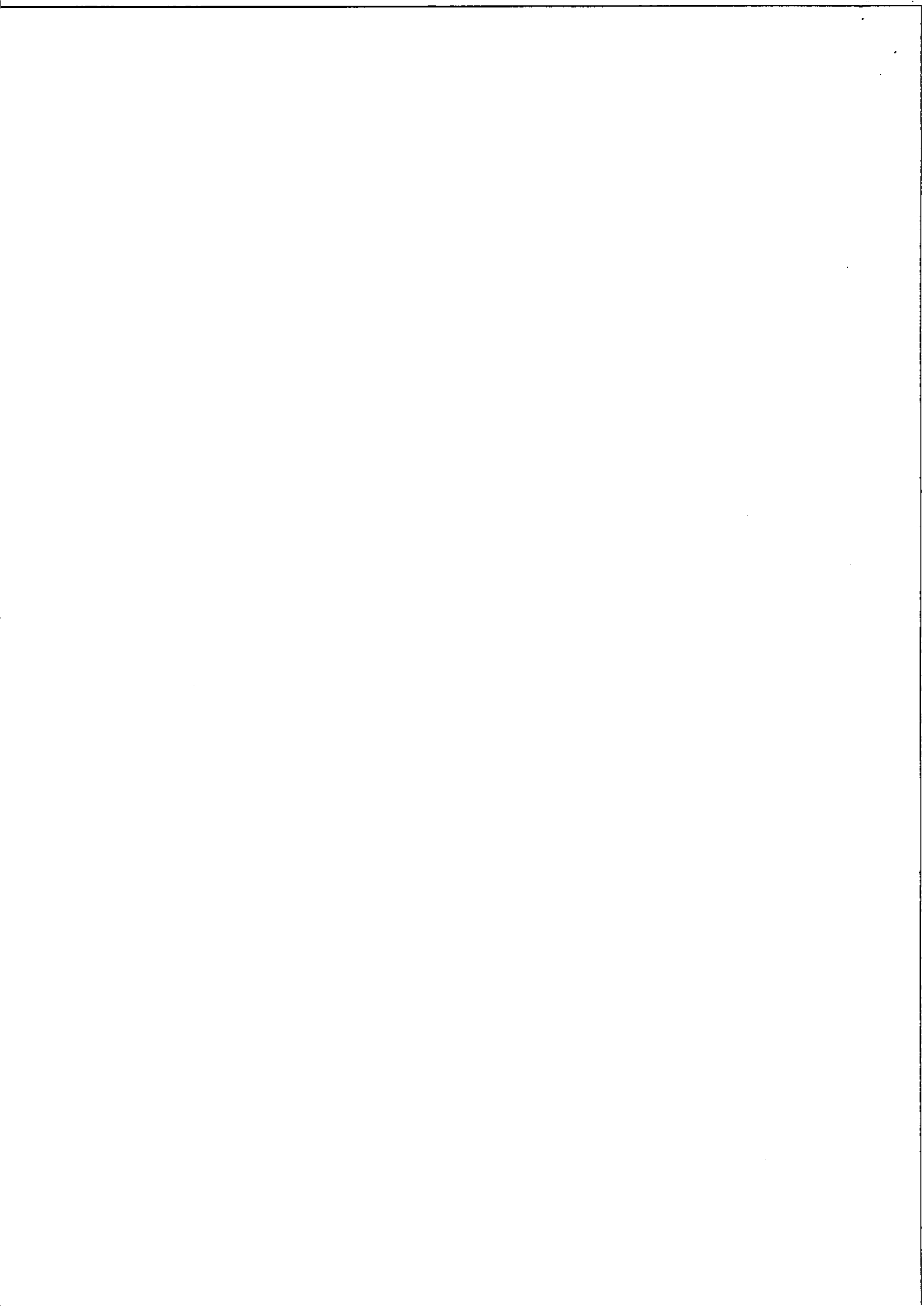

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

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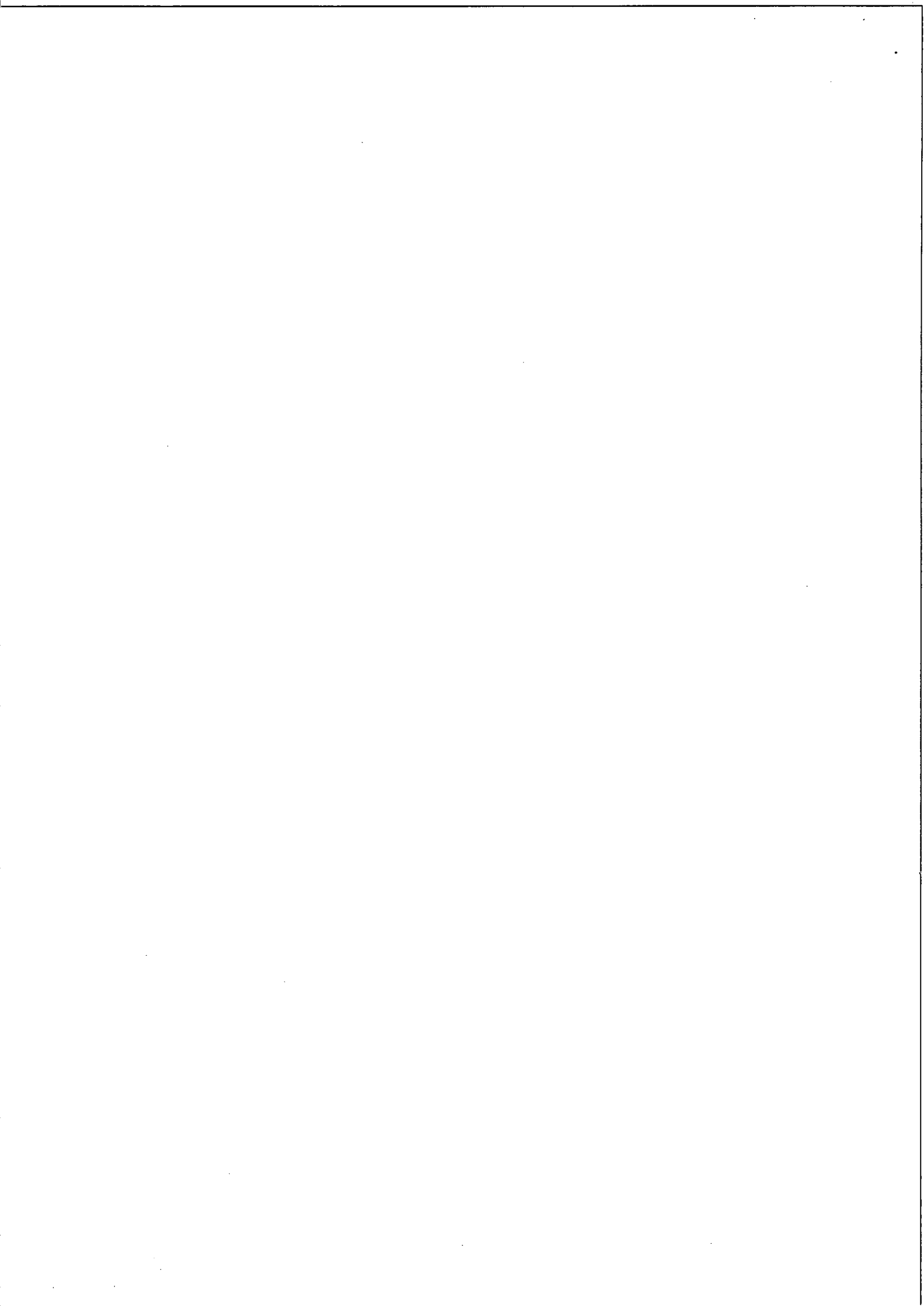

'E_i' means annual energy imported excluding E_w and E_f(GJ/year),
