In accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a revised waste licence to Donegal County Council, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Drumabodan Landfill Site, Kilmacrenan, Co Donegal. This decision was made following consideration of the objection(s) and technical committee report to the Agency's proposed decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts and related Regulations.

The Agency recommends that you meet with Office of Environmental Enforcement (Team B), Environmental Protection Agency, Castlebar, County Mayo, to discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
