Dear Director,

I refer to our earlier notifications (dated 5 January 2009 and 29 September 2010) to Kildare County Council in accordance with articles 18(1) and 18(3) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations in relation to a waste licence application from Cemex (ROI) Limited for a facility located at Walshestown, Blackhall, Tipperkevin and Bawnoge, Naas, Co. Kildare. This application has been assigned register number W0254-01.

An Environmental Impacts Statement (EIS) was submitted by the applicant in support of the licence review application and planning application reference number 08/2159 on 23 December 2008. Additionally, revised elements of EIS were submitted to the Agency on 14 January 2010, 28 September 2010 and 19 November 2010. A copy of the application, the Environmental Impact Statement submitted by the applicant and associated correspondence are available for inspection on the Agency's website www.epa.ie.

You are requested to furnish any observations your Authority might have in relation to the licence application and EIS within **4 weeks of receipt of this notice**.
