## WASTE MANAGEMENT ACTS, 1996 to 2013

## TRANSFER OF A WASTE LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 47(5) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2013

Waste Licence Register No: W0045-01

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2013, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers waste licence register number W0045-01 from Dean Waste Company Limited, Greenview, Greenhills Road, Walkinstown, Dublin 12 to Key Waste Management Limited, Greenview, Greenhills Road, Walkinstown, Dublin 12, CRO No 400662. Waste Licence Register No W0045-01 licenses the carrying on of the waste activities set out below at Greenview, Greenhills Road, Walkinstown, Dublin 12, subject to eleven Conditions, as set out in the waste licence.

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Third Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2013

Class 11: Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.

This activity is limited to the bulking up of non-hazardous commercial, construction /demolition and industrial wastes prior to their recycling or disposal to landfill.

Class 13: Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

This activity is limited to the temporary storage of non-hazardous commercial, construction / demolition and industrial waste at the facility for disposal off-site.



## Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2013

Class 2: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes).

This activity is limited to the recycling of cardboard, paper, timber and plastic wastes at the facility.

Class 3: Recycling ore reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

This activity is limited to the receipt, collection and holding of metal wastes to be sent off site for reprocessing and/or recycling.

Class 4: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.

This activity is limited to the receipt, holding of inert construction and demolition wastes to be sent off site for use as an inert fill for land restoration or other use to be agreed in advance with the Agency.

Class 13: Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

This activity is limited to the storage of non-hazardous commercial, construction / demolition and industrial waste received at the facility, prior to recovery at an alternative appropriate facility.

In accordance with Section 47(6) of the Acts, Key Waste Management Limited is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

## REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 47(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Key Waste Management Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like waste licence. Pursuant to Section 47(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Key Waste Management Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the programme officer's report.
