Re: Waste Licence Application W0250-01 – Kerry Central Recycling Facility Ltd. - Update

Dear Sir/Madam,

We refer to Waste Licence Application W0250-01 which was submitted to the Agency by RPS on the 11th November 2008 on behalf of Kerry Central Recycling Facility Ltd. in respect of the proposed development of a Materials Recovery Facility and associated infrastructure at Scart, Caherdean, Killarney, Co. Kerry.

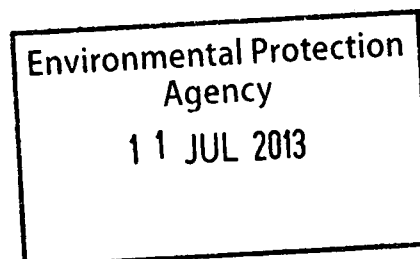
We also refer to an RPS letter issued to the Agency on the 21st February 2013 setting out the history of this application and the applicants intention to submit a revised planning application and EIS to Kerry County Council in the coming months. A copy of this letter is attached for your further information.

We now wish to inform the Agency that Kerry Central Recycling Facility Ltd. intend on submitting a planning application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for a Mechanical Waste Processing Facility and a Public Recycling Centre at Scart and Caherdean, Co. Kerry in the coming weeks.

The proposed facility will process up to a maximum of 95,000 tonnes of waste per year when fully operational. The processes will be carried out will include separating and baling of clean dry recyclables, drying and processing of municipal solid waste and processing construction and demolition waste. Organic waste will be stored at the facility temporarily before being transported offsite to other facilities for final treatment.

It is proposed to development a modern, purpose-built Mechanical Waste Processing Facility including facilities for the mechanical processing of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). The facility is also proposed to accept dry recyclables and construction and demolition waste. It is also proposed to provide short term storage of organic waste. The facility will include a public recycling centre or civic amenity site.

The primary purpose of the facility is to provide pre-treatment of waste prior to further processing and/or landfilling.





The applicant intends to update their waste licence application (Ref: W0250-01) which is currently with the EPA to reflect the particulars of this current development proposal. We therefore request on behalf of the applicant that the application to the Agency for a waste licence for this proposed development remains active.
