re: Notice in accordance with Article 16(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr Jones

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a review of a waste licence relating to a facility at Indaver Ireland Limited (Duleek), Carranstown, Duleek, Meath. Further to the notice issued by the Agency on the 18<sup>th</sup> July 2013 under Article 16(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations this notice is given under Article 16(2) of the Regulations so as to enable the Agency to decide on the application.

#### **ARTICLE 16(2) - FURTHER INFORMATION, PARTICULARS AND EVIDENCE**

If the D10 activity is to be sought for inclusion in a waste licence, you are required as per Article 16(2) of the above mentioned Regulations to carry out the following:

1. re-publish the newspaper notice and erect a new site notice; and,
2. notify the planning authority of all the relevant classes of activity proposed in the licence application,

in line with the requirements of Articles 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request for further information, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (EIS and Application Form), which reflects the further information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the relevant non-technical summary.

Please supply the information in the form of a one original plus two copies within four weeks of the date of this notice. In addition submit sixteen copies of the requested

information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
