re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Dunlea,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Waste Recovery Services (Fermoy) Ltd., Cullenagh, Fermoy, Co. Cork.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. State the amount of C&D waste and any other waste that was deposited into or on to land at or in the environs near to the facility. Include a detailed drawing showing areas where the waste deposition took place.
2. State the cost of excavating all deposited waste, including waste deposited outside the boundary, and having it recovered or disposed of at an off-site authorised waste facility.
3. State the cost of removing all stockpiled waste from the facility and having it recovered or disposed of at an off-site authorised waste facility.
4. Provide evidence to allow the Agency to form an opinion that the applicant, in accordance with the requirements of section 40(7)(c) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2013, is likely to be in a position to meet any financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred by him or her in carrying on the activity to which a waste licence would relate or in consequence of ceasing to carry out on that activity.
5. State whether it is proposed that all areas where waste was deposited are to be included in the site boundary, or provide reasons why these areas should remain excluded from the authorised area. If these areas are to be included in the licensed area, submit a new drawing showing the proposed new site boundary.
6. Submit the information requested in the Agency's notices dated 9 and 18 July 2013.




Your reply to this notice should include a **revised non-technical summary** which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within *two weeks* of the date of this notice. In addition please submit two (2) copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
