
I refer to our earlier notifications (dated 10 March 2010 and 19 August 2013) to Offaly County Council in accordance with articles 18(1) and 18(3) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations in relation to a waste licence application from Bord na Móna PLC for a materials recycling and waste transfer facility located at, Drumman in the townland of Derrygreenagh, Co. Offaly. This application has been assigned register number W0275-01.

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was submitted by the applicant in support of the licence application on 9 March 2010. Additionally, revised elements of EIS were submitted to the Agency on 19 August 2013.
