Re: Technical Amendment

Dear Ms. Doyle

The Environmental Objectives (Groundwater) Regulations 2010, S.I. No. 9 of 2010, require that the Agency examine all licences to determine whether they require a review in order to bring them into compliance with the regulations.

The Agency has examined IPPC and Waste licences in accordance with S.I. No. 9 of 2010 and determined that a number of licences require to be technically amended, in respect of landspreading of organic waste/organic fertiliser to bring the licence into compliance with the Regulations. It is likely that your licence will require a Technical Amendment.

The amendment to your licence will require that landspreading activities be carried out in accordance with European Communities (Good Agricultural Practice for Protection of Waters) Regulations 2010 (S.I. No. 610 of 2010).

You are not required to do anything at this point in time. The <u>scope of the Technical Amendment is strictly limited</u> to the requirements of S.I. No. 9 of 2010. You will shortly receive official notification of the Amendment.
