Re: Technical Amendment

Dear Ms Shine

The Environmental Objectives (Groundwater) Regulations 2010, S.I. No. 9 of 2010, require that the Agency examine all licences to determine whether they require a review in order to bring them into compliance with the regulations.

The Agency has examined IPPC and Waste licences in accordance with S.I. No. 9 of 2010 and determined that your licence is likely to require a Technical Amendment, in respect of

- any waste water treatment system and associated percolation area for the treatment of sanitary effluent and
- landspreading of organic waste/organic fertiliser,


in order to bring the licence into compliance with the Regulations.

The amendment to your licence will require that any waste water treatment system and any percolation area for the treatment of sanitary effluent will satisfy the criteria set out in the *Code of Practice: Waste Water Treatment and Disposal Systems Serving Single Houses*, published by the Environmental Protection Agency within a specified timeframe. The amendment will also require that landspreading activities be carried out in accordance with European Communities (Good Agricultural Practice for Protection of Waters) Regulations 2010 (S.I. No. 610 of 2010).

You are not required to do anything at this point in time. The scope of the Technical Amendment is strictly limited to the requirements of S.I. No. 9 of 2010. You will shortly receive official notification of the Amendment.
