re: Withdrawal by Mr Badri Gharzeddine trading as Enviro Star Solutions of a Waste Licence Application in respect of a facility at Unit 21, Greenouge Industrial Estate, Redzone 613, Rathcoole, Register No. W0288-01, in accordance with the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended

I refer to previous correspondence in relation to the above referenced waste licence application.

I am to advise that Mr Badri Gharzeddine trading as Enviro Star Solutions formally withdrew their application for a waste licence on 18 June 2013 in accordance with Article 21(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended.
