**RE:** Request for Technical Amendment to Waste Licence Register Number **W0156-01**, held by **KTK Sand and Gravel Ltd** in relation to a facility at Kimmeens, Ballymore Eustace West and Coghlanstown East, Co. Kildare.

The inert landfill at Ballymore Eustace is closed and waste acceptance is ceased. The licence was granted in June 2002 and was technically amended in January 2013 for the purposes of the European Communities Environmental Objectives (Groundwater) Regulations 2010.

**Details of request for technical amendment under section 42B of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2013**

The licensee has requested amendment of the licence to allow for the removal of a portion of the landfill area from the licensed area – to partially surrender the licence. An agreement has been reached between the site owner and Kildare County Council to sell 0.5 hectare of land for the purpose of accommodating the new Ballymore Eustace waste water treatment plant. The discharge from the new waste water treatment plant has been authorised by waste water discharge licence register number D0238-01.

Site investigations carried out on the parcel of land shows the deposited waste to be principally comprised of soil and stone. Only one drilling or trial pit log notes concrete waste being encountered. The material in the fill is deemed suitable for construction.

The OEE has carried out an exit audit on the land in question and is satisfied that there are no environmental liabilities outstanding in relation to it.

**Recommendation**

I recommend that the Agency make a technical amendment of licence register number W0029-04 under Section 42B(1)(c) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2013 as proposed in the attached recommendation for a technical amendment.
