## ***Reasons for the Decision***

The Environmental Protection Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that subject to compliance with the conditions of licence Reg. No. W0029-04 granted on 14/10/2010 and amended on 15/1/2013, as well as any amendments noted herein, any emissions from the activity will comply with and not contravene any of the requirements of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2013.

## ***Technical Amendment***

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 42B(1)(c) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2013, the Agency amends Licence Reg. No. W0029-04, granted to Offaly County Council, Áras an Chontae, Charlville Road, Tullamore, County Offaly.

Henceforth, the licence shall be read in conjunction with Amendment A issued on 15/1/2013 and the amendments set out below.

## ***Amendments***

### **Glossary of Terms**

<b>Civic waste facility</b>	The designated area of the facility to which the public have access to deposit waste in receptacles.
<b>Mobile transfer plant</b>	Equipment to be used solely for the bulk transfer of municipal waste delivered to the facility in refuse collection vehicles.
<b>Transfer area</b>	The designated area of the facility illustrated on drawings 11-03-SK04 and 11-03-SK05 provided by the licensee with correspondence dated 15 February 2013 in which mobile transfer plant will be installed for the bulk transfer of municipal waste delivered to the facility in refuse collection vehicles.

**Conditions of Licence**

**1.8.3** Waste may only be accepted at, transferred (operation of mobile transfer plant) and dispatched from the Transfer Area between the hours of:

- 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday; and
- 8.30am and 5.30pm on Saturdays.

Waste shall not be accepted or transferred at the Transfer Area on Sundays or public holidays.

**3.29** The mobile transfer plant to be installed in the Transfer Area shall be operated on an ongoing basis only if agreed by the Agency. No other items of plant and equipment shall be installed in this area unless agreed by the Agency. Notwithstanding the provisions of condition 1.9 of this licence, the Agency may withdraw its agreement under this condition if failure to comply with the conditions of this licence is attributed to operations carried out in the Transfer Area.

**3.30** Drainage from the Transfer Area shall be directed to a collection sump/holding tank or the leachate collection system.

**6.30** Hardstanding surfaces within the Transfer Area shall be kept free from any debris caused by waste transfer activities. Any such debris shall be removed immediately.

**8.20** There shall be no public access to the Transfer Area.

**8.21** Any waste delivered to the Transfer Area shall be removed from the facility prior to the end of the working day. No waste shall be stored in the Transfer Area overnight.
