I refer to your application for a waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Belgooly.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Regulation 16 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Regulation 18(3)(b) of the regulations, to take the steps to supply the information detailed below:

Question	Please clarify whether the sewerage network servicing the four residences and commercial premises in the village centre, as described in the application, is in private ownership, or in the ownership of Cork County Council.

Question	Please provide detail of any plans, including timeframes, for ensuring that the currently untreated discharge from the old sewerage network in the village (designated as "Network 1" in the application) receives appropriate treatment prior to discharge.

Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.
