Dear Ms Babiarczyk,

I refer to the Article 14 Response and I confirm the following:

1. All of the emission points to air, both existing and proposed, are shown on Drawing No 12193-01 Rev B and are labelled as AEP-1 to AEP-8. This drawing supersedes all previous drawing showing emission points.
2. It is not proposed to install a waste dryer at the facility.
3. At present the finished compost is stored inside the compost building in an area that has a capacity to store approximately 150m cubic metres of finished product. It is not proposed to change this arrangement. The digester storage tanks will have a combined capacity of approximately 10,000 cubic meters.
4. The proposed new leachate tank will collect leachate from composting bays that contain Animal By Products (ABP). This is required to avoid cross contamination of non ABP compost. The leachate will be recirculated to the ABP composting bays.
5. In the ELRA, the costing of the 'Worst Case' Scenario is set out in Table 7.1 and amounts to €37,490 including VAT, while the estimated cost of the implementation of the CRAMP is set out in Table 7.2 an amounts to €33,567.93 including VAT.
