Notice under the Habitats Regulations 2011 (SI 477 of 2011)

Dear Mr Luby,

I am to refer to the application for a waste licence relating to the Brownswood Inert Waste Recovery Facility at Brownswood, Enniscorthy, County Wexford. As required by Article 42(2) of the Habitats Regulations 2011 (SI 477 of 2011), the Agency has carried out screening for Appropriate Assessment and, on the basis that significant effects on a European Site cannot be excluded, has determined that Appropriate Assessment of the proposed activity is required. To enable the Agency to carry out Appropriate Assessment it will be necessary to prepare and submit to the Agency a Natura Impact Statement (NIS). The NIS shall address the requirements of Article 42(5) of the above Regulations.
