Recommendation to consider a waste licence to have

been withdrawn: Register Number W0246-01,

RE: Thornbush Holdings Limited, Former Mitsui Denman

Plant, Wallingstown & Inchera, Little Island Road,

Little Island, Co. Cork.

Correspondence was received from Declan Waugh on 9 October 2013 on behalf of Thornbush Holdings Limited confirming their intention to withdraw waste licence application Register No. W0246-01.

The site which is the subject of this waste licence application is currently covered by an IPPC licence (Register No. P0389-01) and site restoration is ongoing at the installation. Thornbush Holdings Limited and the Office of Environmental Enforcement have agreed to continue the restoration of the installation in accordance with the conditions of this IPPC licence.

A waste licence is not required for this facility as the applicant confirmed that they no longer wish to carry out the recovery of construction and demolition waste at the site and the IPPC licence can facilitate the restoration of the installation.

Recommendation

I recommend that in accordance with article 21 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended, the Agency moves to consider the application to have been withdrawn.
