Request for Amendment of certain Licence Conditions.

Dear Mr Clinton,

As a licensee I am aware that all Intensive Agriculture IPPC licences have to be examined by the EPA and might have to be amended by 7th January 2014 to make them compliant with the Industrial Emissions Directive.

I request the EPA to ensure when examining my licence with a view to amending it as may be required by 7 January 2014, that an amendment done to satisfy that requirement will include also the amendments necessary to resolve the outstanding licence conditions issues that have been the subject of recent discussions between the IFA and the EPA. I refer in particular to the issues identified and discussed in a letter dated 11th December 2013 from Par O'Flaherty, Chairman of the IFA Pigs and Pigmeat Committee to Mr Frank Clinton, Programme Manager and Mr Patrick Byrne, Senior Inspector, both in the EPA's Office of Licensing Climate and Resource Use.

All of the issues referred to there are very important to me and the management of my licensed activity. I appreciate all the progressive changes made to licence conditions over a prolonged period of discussions between IFA and the EPA and I hope and expect that the EPA can deal properly and fairly with those remaining issues without further delay.
