3. **Objection to Proposed Decision of an Application for a Waste Licence**

(i) *Licensee:* **Greenstar Recycling (Munster) Limited**
Sarsfieldcourt Industrial Estate
Sarsfieldcourt
Glanmire
Cork

Register of Licence No: **W0136-03**

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Decision issued on 16 October 2013; 1 First-Party objection received on 27 September 2013; Addendum to the Inspectors Report dated 29 January 2014 and the report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Michael Owens gave a verbal presentation.

Technical Committee Report

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee subject to the following amendments;

(ii) ***Condition 3.10.6 – Tonnage limits per annum for hazardous waste***

Amend Condition 3.10.6(i) to read as follows; ‘Household *hazardous* waste.’

Amend Note 1 of Schedule A.2 to read as follows; ‘The quantities of the individual waste only *with* the agreement remaining the same.’

(iii) ***Condition 3.19.3 – Containment Pond***

Amend Condition 3.19.3 to read as follows; ‘In the event of a fire or a spillage diverted *for collection*. The licensee shall examine, as diversion of storm water *for collection*. The licensee shall to firewater retention.’

(iv) ***Condition 3.21 – Onsite Weather Station***

Insert new Condition 3.22 to read as follows; ‘*The licensee shall, within three months of the date of grant of this licence, install in a prominent location on the site a wind sock, or other wind direction indicator, which shall be visible from the public roadway outside the site.*’

(x) Condition 8.15 – Removal of Putrescible Waste

Delete the last sentence from the Technical Committee’s recommendation as follows; ‘Baled and wrapped RDF/SRF weeks of its production.’

Insert new Condition 8.19 to read as follows; *‘Baled and wrapped RDF/SRF shall only be stored at the facility with the approval of the Agency’*

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified to Greenstar Recycling (Munster) Limited, for their facility at, Sarsfieldcourt Industrial Estate, Sarsfieldcourt, Glanmire, Cork, Register of Licence No W0136-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
