Where the licensable activity has not yet commenced, you are required to provide adequate notice to the Agency (to both the Enforcement Inspector from the Office of Environmental Enforcement, and the licensing inspector from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use) of the intended date of commencement of the activity.
