Dear Mr. Power

I am to refer to your incomplete application for a waste licence review, Reg. No W0214-02 which was received by the Agency on 02/10/2008.

As you are aware, on the 4<sup>th</sup> April 2009 Cork County Council made a decision (Planning File No. 094547) to refuse planning permission for the proposed increase of the facility's waste acceptance threshold to 60,000 tonnes per annum for reasons including that the proposed development would be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

In accordance with Article 21(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 the Agency is of the opinion that the licence review application has been abandoned. I enclose a Notice in accordance with Article 21(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended.

If no submission is received within the period specified in the notice, the application will be regarded as having been withdrawn.

Failure to provide the outstanding information within the time limit will also be regarded as indicating withdrawal of the application

The Agency is empowered to regard the application as having been withdrawn even if a submission is made and/or the documentation furnished. You should therefore treat this notice as one of primary importance.
