Re: Notice for the purposes of Section 76A(3) of the Waste Management Act, as amended

Dear Mr Jones,

With reference to your application for a Waste Licence [reg. no. W0167-03, received 23/04/2012] the Agency would draw your attention to a change in the applicable rules. Pursuant to the European Union (Industrial Emissions) Regulations 2013, Part IV of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 has been amended and the Agency is now required to determine the application under the new Part IV.

A valid application for a licence must now contain the information prescribed in Regulation 9 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions)(Licensing) Regulations, 2013 (a copy of which is attached). You are requested to furnish such information as is necessary to comply with these requirements by 02/04/2014.

Alternatively, if you so wish, you may withdraw your application and resubmit it as a new application under the new Part IV. If you opt to furnish the Agency with the required information rather than take the withdrawal option, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should be directed to [Ann Kehoe], Administration Officer, Office of Climate, Licensing & Resource Use, Environmental Protection Agency, P.O. Box 3000, Johnstown Castle, Co. Wexford. In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply. If you need extra time to submit this information, please contact the undersigned to arrange an extended deadline.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with.

This notice is issued for the purposes of Section 76A(3) of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as amended.
