RE:	Clerical Amendment to IED Licence Reg No. W0009-03, Fingal County Council – Balleally Landfill, Balleally, Lusk, Co. Dublin

Background

Fingal County Council operates a landfill at Balleally, Lusk, Co. Dublin. Waste acceptance ceased in May 2012. A licence was originally granted in February 2000. Revised licences were granted in January 2003 and December 2009. The existing licence was technically amended in June 2010 and amended again on 19 December 2013 for the purpose of bringing it into conformity with the provisions and requirements of Council Directive 2010/75/EU on industrial emissions. A further Technical Amendment was issued on 12th March 2014, entitled Technical Amendment B.

Technical Amendment B issued with a typographical error in the *Reasons for the Decision* section. Fingal County Council is named as being responsible for the waste water treatment plant (D0114-01) which accepts the landfill effluent, whereas it should be Irish Water that holds this responsibility.

Requested Amendments

This amendment is required to correct this clerical error and allow for the correct information to be contained within the Amendment.

Recommendation

I recommend that the requested licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached Recommended Clerical Amendment.
