
Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of our client *Lennon Quarries Ltd.,* with regards to their EPA Waste Licenced Facility at Tallagh, Belmullet, County Mayo (W0256-01).

EPA Waste Licence W0256-01 was granted on 20 May 2011, allowing the recovery of soil & stones, by deposition on the site at Tallagh, Belmullet, County Mayo, by *Lennon Quarries Ltd.* 

An application for a Review of Waste Licence W0256-01 issued to the EPA on 22 August 2012 (i.e. W0256-02).

This correspondence is in response to a 'Notice in Accordance with Section 42 (1i)(b) of the Waste Management Act 1996-2013, as inserted by S.I. No. 505 of 2013', received from the EPA, dated 28 February 2014.



The above Notice requested that the applicant submit an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), in support of Waste Licence Review Application W0256-02, within 16 weeks of the date of the Notice (i.e. before 20 June 2014).

In addition to the EIS, the Notice required that: a new site notice be erected; a new newspaper notice be published; and a new notification to the Planning Authority be issued, in accordance with Articles 5, 6, 7 & 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004.

The following revised notices were reissued/erected and copies are now attached:
