The EPA will be aware that the above license applications propose the disposal of untreated (i.e. uncured) bottom ash to landfill.

The Agency will also be aware that the generation of Hydrogen Gas Emissions during the naturally occurring "curing" process of bottom ash subsequent to deposition in a landfill is a well documented phenomenon, and may give rise to associated risks of fire and/or explosion.

The residents of Hollywood and District would request the EPA to address this important Health and Safety issue with both applicants.
