
Dear Mr Power,

I am to refer to your application for a Waste licence Review, Reg. No. W0214-02 and in particular to the Agency's notice under Article 21(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 as amended, requiring you to make a submission to the Agency as to why the review application should not be regarded as having been withdrawn.

The Agency notes your submission and the fact that planning permission (File No. 094547) was refused on the 14th April 2009 for the proposed increase in the waste acceptance threshold from 23,000 to 60,000 tonnes per annum. No further applications with regard to an increase in the waste acceptance threshold have been submitted to the planning authority for approval.

Therefore, pursuant to the notice under Article 21(2) and in accordance with Article 21(3) of the said Regulations, the Agency hereby declares that the review application, Reg. No. W0214-02, is regarded as having been withdrawn.
