**Notification under Section 87(1I)(f)(i) of the EPA Act, as amended**

Dear Mr Stewart

I refer to previous correspondence in relation to a licence review application, Registration number: W0140-04.

The Agency has decided that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is required in relation to the activity concerned and on the 27 March 2014 the applicant was requested to submit an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) under Section 87(1I)(b) of the EPA Act as amended. The EIS was received by the Agency on the 26 May 2014. In accordance with Section 87(1I)(e) of the EPA Act as amended, the application for a licence is deemed to be made on the date of receipt by the Agency of the EIS.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of Section 87(1I)(f)(i) of the EPA Act as amended, you are being notified that an application for a licence **review**, to which Section 87(1I)(f)(i) of the EPA Act as amended, applies, was received by the Agency on 26 May 2014.
