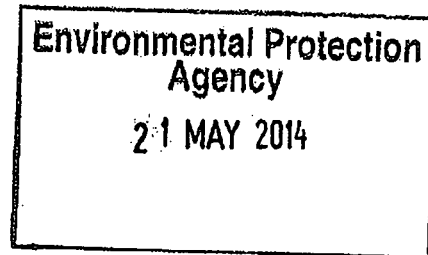

Dear Patrick,

Further to our recent phone conversation regarding the waste licence application no. WO 251-01, I have made the decision not to proceed at this point in time with the restoration of the land at Wolfestown, Eadestown, Naas, County Kildare. I would therefore like to withdraw the waste licence application received by your office on the 13/11/2008.

In addition to the above-mentioned application, a waste permit was obtained from Kildare County Council in 2007 (Permit No. 262/2007) for the same land. This permit has since expired. The facility has remained undeveloped with no waste or aggregate having been accepted or removed from the site in the years since the granting of the permit.

The main decision not to proceed in 2007/2008 with the land restoration and waste licence application was determined at that time by business and economic factors. In seeking to withdraw the licence application, I would like to request a refund of the licence application fee of €10,000 (or part thereof).
