RE: Ladybridge Waste Water Licence Application (D0467-01)

Dear Loretta Joyce,

During the course of an EPA inspection of the Ladysbridge WWTP, the agglomeration population equivalent for Ladybridge and the requirement for a waste water discharge licence was queried.

In response to this query, Irish Water has conducted a review of the estimated agglomeration load. Based on 2011 CSO population data and a low non-domestic factor, it is estimated that the Ladysbridge agglomeration currently generates a loading of 497 P.E and the estimated population equivalent for 2020 is 516 P.E based on an annual growth rate of 0.644%<sup>1</sup>.

It is therefore confirmed that Irish Water wish to proceed with the waste water discharge licence application for the Ladybridge agglomeration.

The Ladysbridge WWTP has a design capacity of 1,000 P.E.
