Class 10: Spreading of any waste on land with a consequential benefit for an agricultural activity or ecological system, including composting and other biological transformation processes.

Other activities of the fourth schedule will also include:

Class 4: Recycling or reclamation of other norganic materials

Class 3: Recycling or reclamation of metal compounds.

Class 13: Storage of waste intended to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

A copy of the application for the waste licence application, Environmental Impact Statement and further information relating to the application may be furnished to the Agency in the course of its consideration of the application will as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the EPA headquarters.
