**RE: RESTORATION OF FORMER QUARRY, MILVERTON, SKERRIES, CO. DUBLIN
APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE
LICENCE (REF. NO. W0272-01)**

We write on behalf of our Client, Roadstone Ltd., of Fortunestown, Tallaght, Dublin 24, to advise that it has made an application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a waste licence (Ref. No W0272-01) in respect of a proposed inert waste recovery facility on its lands at Milverton, Skerries, Co. Dublin (National Grid Reference 3247E, 2592N). The waste licence application provides for the use of approximately 1,900,000m³ of inert natural materials, principally soil, stones and/or broken rock, to backfill a large existing void created by rock extraction;

The principal activity is Class R5 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts 1996-2013 (recycling or reclamation of inorganic materials). Other activities include Class R3 of the Fourth Schedule (recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents) and Class R13 of the Fourth Schedule (storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12).

In accordance with Section 42(1)(b) of the Waste Management Acts 1996-2013, as amended by the EU(EIA) Regulations (S.I. No 505 of 2013), the Agency has requested that an amended Environmental Impact Statement be submitted to it in support of the Waste Licence Application. A copy of

- (i) the Waste Licence Application,
- (ii) the Environmental Impact Statement and
- (iii) further information relating to the application that may be furnished to the Agency in the course of its consideration of the licence application

will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the headquarters of the Agency.

This letter constitutes formal written notice of the Waste Licence Application as required by Section 9(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004).
