Confirm that you wish to proceed with your application for a Waste Water Discharge Licence for the Ballydehob agglomeration, and confirm the current and projected (2020) p.e.; or Confirm that you wish to withdraw the Waste Water Discharge Licence application.

Irish Water has conducted a review of the estimated agglomeration load and based on 2011 CSO population data and a 10% non-domestic factor, it is estimated that the Ballydehob agglomeration currently generates a loading of 326 P.E (winter) – 687P.E(summer) and the estimated population equivalent for 2020 is 338P.E (Winter) – 699P.E (Summer) based on an annual growth rate of 0.644%¹. Irish Water therefore confirms its intend to proceed with the Waste Water Discharge Licence for the Ballydehob agglomeration.
