I am to refer to your letter of 13 May 2014, received on 21 May 2014 notifying the Agency of your withdrawal of the above referenced waste licence application.

The Agency hereby acknowledges that you have formally withdrawn the above referenced waste licence application pursuant to the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 as amended. That being the case, it is no longer the function of the Agency to consider any documentation received by it which relates to the above application.

The Agency has informed Kildare County Council, who is the appropriate enforcement authority, of this and that you have withdrawn your application for a waste licence, (see Agency website).

It should be noted, for future reference, that it is an offence liable to prosecution to carry on a waste activity which requires a waste licence in the absence of such a licence.
