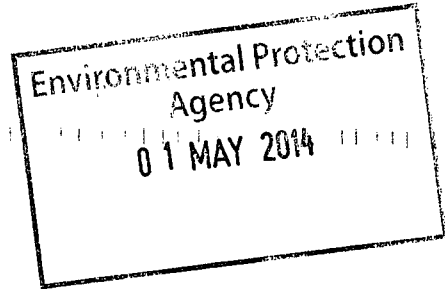

Re: Waste Licence Application W0250-01 – Kerry Central Recycling Facility Ltd. – Request for Refund of Fees Associated with Waste Licence Withdrawal

Dear Sir/Madam,

We act on behalf of Kerry Central Recycling Facility Ltd. and refer to waste licence application W0250-01 and to a letter dated 18th October 2013. This letter set out the applicants request to have the waste licence application withdrawn and the application fees of €22,000 retained by the EPA for the purpose of future possible applications made by the applicant.

Further to this request we now wish to ask the Agency, on behalf of the applicant, that half of this fee of €22,000 (i.e. €11,000) be refunded to the applicant and the remaining €11,000 should be retained by the Agency and put towards the cost of a future waste licence application made by the applicant.

We request that the Agency confirm in writing that this proposal is acceptable.
