

Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended Notice under Regulation 37(2) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013

The Agency granted an Industrial Emissions licence subject to conditions, on 13th August 2014 to Bord Gáis Éireann, PO Box 51, Gas Works Road, Cork, Reg. No. W0281-01, for Class 11.2(b): The disposal or recovery of hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 tonnes per day and Class 11.1: The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required, located at Limerick Gasworks, Dock Road, Limerick, .
