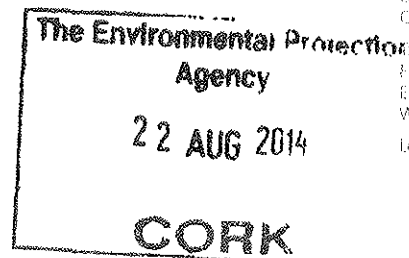

Dear Mr. Dowling,

I refer to your application for a licence review, which was received by the Agency on 4 April 2014.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, that the following information is required in support of the application:

Due to a lack of clarity in existing site drawings and the location of authorised activities, please provide three up to date, newly surveyed drawings of the installation, as follows:

Drawing 1

- The proposed site boundary or boundaries on one drawing;
- The location of all buildings, storage areas/tanks, weighbridge and other aspects of the installation; and
- The location of all fences and boundary markings.

Drawing 2

The existing licensed site boundary as authorised in licence register no. W0082-02 superimposed onto a drawing of the proposed, newly-surveyed site boundary.

Drawing 3

The area of land owned or leased by Starrus Eco-Holdings superimposed onto a drawing of the proposed, newly-surveyed site boundary.

The purpose of this request is to ensure that all waste activities are enclosed within the site boundary, that there has been no reduction in the area enclosed by the site boundary and that Starrus Eco Holdings Ltd. are entitled to so designate the site boundary. The drawings should be completed from new surveys carried out on the ground by appropriately qualified persons.


In addition to the above please also provide an **updated non-technical summary** to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *four weeks* of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 1 copy in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should quote the register number **W0082-03** and be directed to Ms. Sonja Smith, Administration Officer, Office of Climate, Licensing, Resources & Research, EPA Regional Inspectorate, Inniscarra, County Cork.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact Ms. Ewa Babiarczyk at the number above.
