I refer to your application for a licence, which was received on 08/08/2012 and in particular the submission of further information, in July 201, in support of Regulation 9 of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013.

I am to advise in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, the following information is required in support of the application under the Regulations:

- As required under Regulation 9 (2) (k), please review the results of the groundwater monitoring data from on-site boreholes together with soil sampling results in the context of Recommended soil and groundwater standards. The review should be carried out by an appropriately qualified and experienced professional. Reference may be made to the various EPA publications in this area, in particular "Guidance on the Management of Contaminated Land and Groundwater at EPA Licensed Sites, 2013, available on the EPA's website.

In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within **eight weeks** of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.


