Re: Application for Waste Licence (W082-03) Greenstar, Dock Road, Limerick

Dear Ms Smith,

I refer to the Agency's letter dated the 20th August 2014 in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions)(Licensing) Regulations 2013. The requested information is set out in italics followed by the response.

Due to a lack of clarity in existing site drawing said the location of authorised activities, please provide three up to date, newly surveyed drawings of the installation as follows;

Drawing I

- The proposed site boundaries or boundaries on one drawing;
- The location of all buildings, storage areas/tanks, weighbridge and other aspects of the installation:
- *The location of all fences and boundary markings.*

As already stated in the application, it is not proposed to amend the boundary authorised in Licence Reg. No. W0082-02. The licence boundary (shown in red), locations of all buildings, storage areas/tanks, weighbridge and other aspects of the installation, including all fences and boundary markings, are shown on Drawing No 1.

The boundary is based on the orange area shown on Drawing No C98-101-B2-01 Rev 2 and the green area shown on Drawing No C98-101-B2-01, copies of which are also included. This is specified in Condition 1.2 of the existing Licence. Sections of the licensed boundary are not physically delineated on the ground by fence lines.

The existing licensed site boundary as authorised in licence register no. W0082-02 superimposed on a drawing of the proposed, newly surveyed site boundary

The existing licensed site boundary is shown in red on Drawing No 1, which includes information arising from a survey completed in August 2014. As referred to above it is not proposed to change the licence boundary.

Drawing No 3

The area of land owned or leased by Starrus Eco Holdings superimposed onto a drawing of the proposed newly surveyed site boundary.

Starrus Eco Holdings Ltd do not own the land on which the facility is located. The area leased by Starrus Eco Holdings Ltd is marked in yellow on Drawing No 3. The leased area is includes all of the area on which waste activities are carried out. This operational area is delineated on the ground by a security fence, which is shown on the Drawing. Starrus Eco Holdings does not carry out any waste activities outside the leased area.
