I refer to the application for a licence review by Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited, for their facility located at Hollywood Great, Nags Head, The Naul, County Dublin, Reg. No. W0129-03, and in particular to your request for an oral hearing in relation to the objection to the proposed determination.

I am to advise that, having considered your request, the Board of the Agency decided on **2 September 2014** that it would not be appropriate in this case to hold an oral hearing.

The reason for the decision not to hold an oral hearing is as follows:


There are no new issues raised nor significant new information or data provided in the objection.

In light of this decision the Board of the Agency wishes to assure you that the refusal of your request for an oral hearing does not mean that your objection will receive any less consideration than where a hearing is granted. They also wish to advise that the technical committee will deal with your objection in a professional and impartial manner.

The technical committee will prepare a report and recommendations having taken into account all the issues raised in your objection. The Board of the Agency will consider your objection together with the report and the recommendations of the technical committee before making a final decision. This decision will be made as soon as possible and without undue delay. Once the final decision is made you will be notified at the earliest possible date.

The decisions of the Agency are based on objective and independent evaluation of all the issues raised by all parties to a licence application. The Agency is committed to openness, fairness and transparency in its decision making process and I can assure you that you will have access to all documentation in relation to this licence application including the report and recommendations of the technical committee.
