2. Please state whether there are any convictions against the applicant under the acts listed in section 40(7)(a) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.
3. Please provide any comments you might have in respect of the applicant and requirements for 'Fit and Proper Person' under Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.
4. Please provide a summary of any complaints received in respect of the permitted activity in the period of the existing waste facility permit.
5. Please submit copies or links to Annual Environmental Reports (AERs) in respect of the activity in the period of the existing waste facility permit.
6. Please state whether, to the knowledge of Cork County Council, waste other than soil and stones (EWC code 17 05 04) and mixed construction & demolition waste (EWC code 17 01 07) has been deposited at the facility. If yes, provide details on types and amounts of this waste.



7. Please provide results of any groundwater or other environmental monitoring carried out at the facility by the Council.
8. Please state whether quarrying has ever taken place within the site boundary of the facility.
9. In relation to Point 4 of your correspondence of 9 July 2014, please clarify the Council's expectations regarding such a condition and the environmental impacts to be addressed by such a condition.
10. It is stated that the development objective at the facility is the improvement of agricultural land. Please provide any observations you may have in relation to:
 - reasons for the use of a 3 metre depth of fill in order to achieve the stated development objective; and
 - whether, in the opinion of Cork County Council, the development objective can be achieved using a shallower fill.
