In accordance with Article 9 (1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004), we wish to give written notice of the following application for a Waste License Application to the Environmental Protection Agency, on behalf of Sand and Gravel Merchants Ltd, Upper Punchestown, Rathmore, Naas, County Kildare. i.e.

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE

Sand and Gravel Merchants Ltd, Upper Punchestown, Rathmore, Naas, County Kildare intend to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for a waste licence for the continued operation of its existing waste recovery facility on lands at Thornberry Townland, Kill, Co. Kildare (National Grid Reference 295986E 221275N).

The nature of the development is the continued phased restoration of a sand and gravel pit using imported inert soils, stone, and recovery of inert construction and demolition waste. Up to 70,000 cubic metres per annum is being accepted to the site and circa 25,000 cubic metres is required to complete the restoration of the site.

The principal activity is Class R5 (recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials) of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended. Other activities include Class R13 of the Fourth Schedule (storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 12).

The waste licence application (W0264-01) was submitted on 13/02/2009. In accordance with Section 40 (2A)(C) of the Waste Management Acts (1996-2013), the Agency has assessed the information submitted and considers that the application must be made subject to an environmental impact assessment (EIA).

An environmental impact statement will be submitted to the Agency with the application.

A copy of the application for a waste licence, environmental impact statement and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the headquarters of the Agency.

THE COUNTY OF KILDARE ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER NRO 2/2014

Kildare County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act 2004, hereby makes the following Order in respect of the area comprising the administrative County of Kildare;

This order may be cited as the Road Works Speed Limit Order NRO 2/2014

80 kilometres per hour shall be the Road Works Speed Limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on the roads specified in the First Schedule to this order;

60 kilometres per hour shall be the Road Works Speed Limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on the roads as specified in the Second Schedule to this order;

First Schedule

Roads in respect of which a Road Works Speed Limit Order of **80 kilometres per hour** is prescribed

M7 Motorway

- Westbound Carriageway M7 from a point approximately 1 km east of Junction 11 to a point approximately 400 metres east of Junction 11.
- Westbound Carriageway M7 between a point approximately 1.2 km west of Junction 12 to a point approximately 1.7 km west of Junction 12.
- Eastbound Carriageway M7 between a point approximately 400 metres east of Junction 11 to a point approximately 1 km east of Junction 11.
- Eastbound Carriageway M7 between a point approximately 1.7 km west of Junction 12 to a point approximately 1.2 km west of Junction 12.
- M9 merge with M7 (eastbound) from a distance approximately 500 metres west of the M7/M9 merge.
- M9 merge with M7 (westbound) from Junction 11 for a distance of approximately 400 metres from M7/M9 diverge.

Second Schedule

Roads in respect of which a Road Works Speed Limit Order of **60 kilometres per hour** is prescribed

M7 Motorway

- Westbound Carriageway M7 from a point approximately 400 metres east of Junction 11 to a point approximately 1.2 km west of Junction 12.
- Eastbound Carriageway M7 from a point approximately 1.2 km west of Junction 12 to a point approximately 400 metres east of Junction 11.
- Junction 12 merge/diverge ramps.

The consent of An Garda Síochána and the National Roads Authority have been obtained to these temporary speed limits.

This Road Works Speed Limit Order will apply from Wednesday 8 October 2014 to Friday 5 December 2014 inclusive

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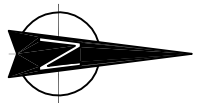
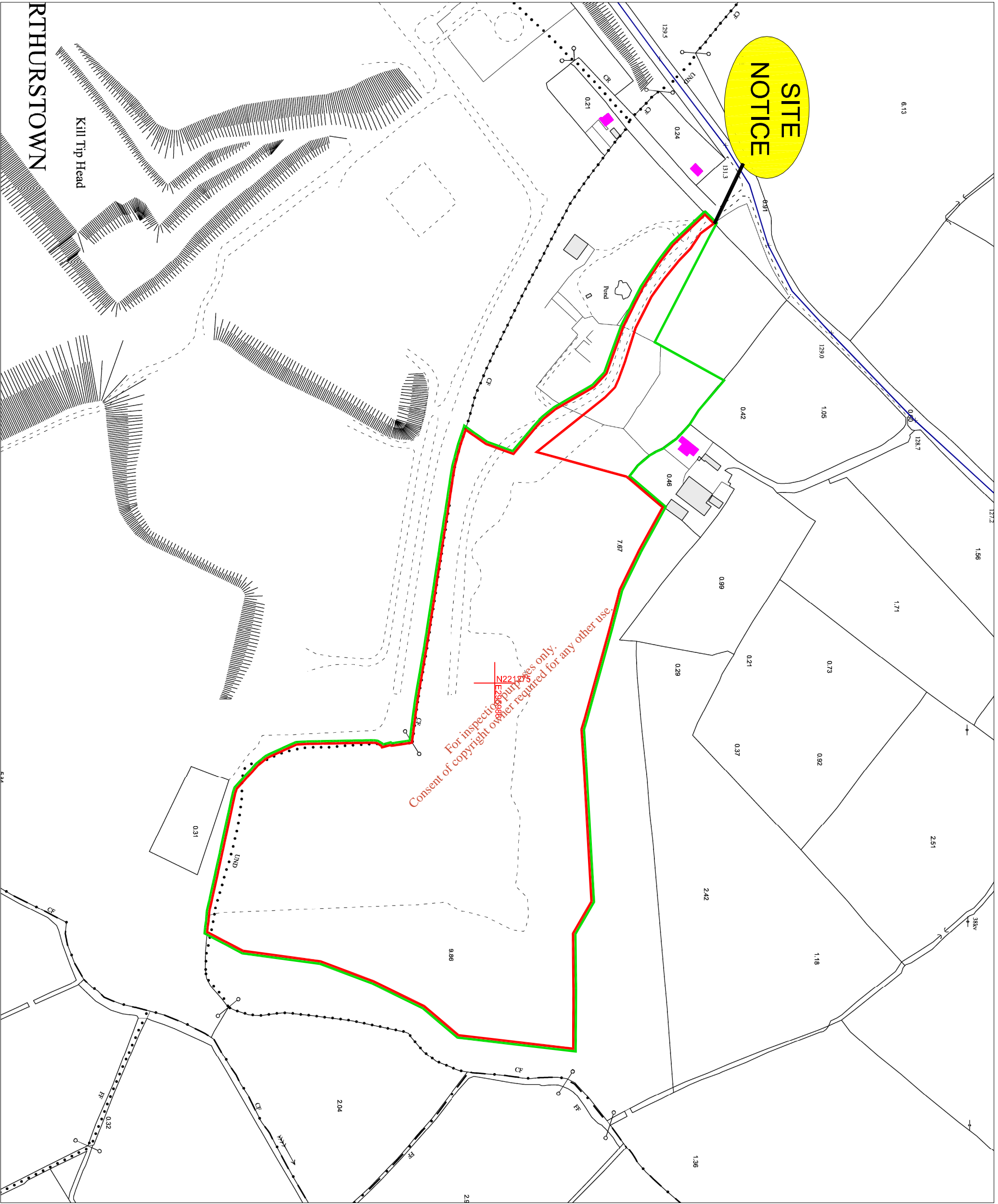
