The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and agreed to amend Schedule B.2 as follows: Delete the ELV of 1mg/l for ammonia (as N) and replace with 5mg/l total ammonia (as N).

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Waterford County Council, for their facility at, Dungarvan Waste Disposal Site, Ballynamuck Middle, Dungarvan, County Waterford, Register of Licence No W0032-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
